GRAND MARSHAL #1 Regina Hillman

Regina Hillman is a law professor at the University of Memphis Cecil C. Humphreys School of Law where she teaches Legal Methods, Professional Responsibility, and Gender & the Law.

Prior to teaching law full time, Regina was co-counsel in Tanco v. Haslam, the Tennessee marriage equality case that challenged the constitutionality of Tennessee's constitutional and statutory bans on recognition of valid out-of-state same-sex marriages. That case was combined with other Sixth Circuit marriage equality cases from Ohio, Michigan, and Kentucky, and went up to the United States Supreme Court as Obergefell v. Hodges. The Supreme Court's favorable ruling on June 26, 2015, resulted in to marriage equality nationwide.

Regina's scholarship focuses on the advancement of LGBTQ+ legal rights, including the history and progression of LGBTQ+ rights in Tennessee, and Title VII federal discrimination protections for LGBTQ+ employees. Her current work-in-progress analyzes the Supreme Court's Title VII decision that sexual orientation and gender identity are protected under the federal statute, including the resulting broad application to federal discrimination laws, anticipated challenges, and the need to codify these protections constitutionally.

Regina graduated from The University of Memphis in 1997 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in English and graduated from the University of Tennessee College of Law in 2001. While in Knoxville, Regina taught legal writing as an adjunct law professor at the University of Tennessee College of Law while practicing law full-time in the area of complex litigation involving business, employment, and corporate matters.



Regina is married to the love of her life, Natalie Hillman, and they share an embarrassing number of Standard Poodles, Chihuahuas, and a toy poodle, Lilli.

GRAND MARSHAL #2 ARTavius Veasey



Kim Chi is a 7' tall, live-action anime character and high-fashion model. Born in the U.S., raised in South Korea, and currently based in CHicago, Kim is cultural hybrid with a ppreternatural understanding of style and conceptual fashion. One cannot bound Kim Chi with any stylistic stereotypes. She deftly absorbs and interptrets our contemporary cultural milieu with unflinching focus. An ever-evolving chameleon, Kim never fails to surprise and delight with her larger than life looks and her high standard of work.

Kim's work encapsulates the transcendental nature of drag, as the seemingly simple act of a man putting on a dress is transformed into fine art. Follow her career to experience the possibilities of her otherworldly creative vision.



Brody Ray

Brody's life started out different from most. Brody, born female, knew that his body didn't match what he felt on the inside, as young as a toddler. Brody's mother remembers him kicking the back of her seat in the McDonald's Drive-Thru until he got the boy toy in his happy meal, and jumping around in diapers and cowboy boots with a guitar singing at the top of his lungs, doing all the things boys did.



As Brody got older his love for music grew as well as his desire to become the man he always felt he was on the inside. Brody got the top surgery and hormones he needed to complete the male image he had always seen himself having. During this process, TLC got in contact with Brody and they captured some of his most trying times going through this journey to become who he was inside, struggling with relationships, hormones, surgeries, and family. Brody's episode was featured on a show called Strange Sex, on May 8th, 2011 and they named his episode "Right Guy, Wrong Body". You can find his episode still airing on the Oprah Winfrey Network, Discovery Fit and Health, TLC, Netflix, and YouTube.

Shortly after the airing of the episode, Brody lost his voice due to his body and voice trying to adjust to the testosterone injections once a week. Brody worked hard daily retraining and trying to recover his singing voice. After two years of dedication, Brody was able to sing again and sound like he's always imagined with a deeper, more fitting voice. He then found the confidence to audition for shows like American Idol and The Voice.

At the beginning of 2018, Brody auditioned for America's Got Talent, earning a chance to sing in front of the Celebrity judges Howie Mandel, Mel B, Heidi Klum, and Simon Cowell.

After shocking the judges and crowd with his story of transitioning, he then went on to sing his stunning and moving rendition of "Stand In the Light" by Jordan Smith. Simon commented by saying he was "A force to be reckoned with." His first performance aired on June 26th, 2018, earning him 4 yeses from all of the judges. Brody moved on the the 'Judge Cuts' where he got to perform an original song requested by Simon called "Wake Your Dreams". The episode is on Season 13 and can be found streaming on Netflix and YouTube.

Shortly after the airing of America's Got Talent, Brody was quick to release 3 new singles, 'Wake Your Dreams', 'Stand In the Light' and 'Take It Too Far' with Skyfall Records in Nashville. All of his new music can be found on all streaming and digital platforms worldwide.

That idea was the beginning of his early plan for what now is the 501c3, The PAIGE Inc.




D-Love Saviyon
