

MEET YOUR GRAND MARSHALS



Lacretia Lamour

Lacretia Lamour, a proud Black and Chinese trans elder, was born on September 29, 1947, and raised in Tupelo, Mississippi. From an early age, Lacretia embodied resilience and purpose—joining the Army in their youth and later attending Lane College, where they studied Business Management with a minor in Spanish.

They were active in the Civil Rights Movement, working on voter rights—laying the groundwork for a lifelong commitment to justice. Lacretia went on to become a skilled barber and cosmetology

instructor, eventually gaining national recognition as a platform artist for Hawaiian Silky hair products. Their career and charisma took them across the United States and Europe.

Lacretia is a survivor of anti-trans violence and domestic violence. Through it all, they never stopped showing up—for themselves or for community. Now based in Memphis, Tennessee, Lacretia serves as the Volunteer Manager at WeCareTn and works as an HIV Educator and Prevention Specialist. They also mentor pageant contestants, teaching refinement and runway presentation with elegance and pride.

Their trailblazing work has earned them recent honors, including the Torch Award at the National Trans Visibility March in Los Angeles and the Living Legend Award at the Trans Girls Rock Gala.

At 78 years old, Lacretia Lamour continues to inspire the Black TLGBQIA community as a fierce, unapologetic trans person—a living legacy of truth, grace

MEET YOUR GRAND MARSHALS



Jessie Claudio

Jessie Claudio is an activist, educator, and public health professional with over five years of experience advancing sexual health, community empowerment, and equity across the South. A proud first-generation Mexican-American and the first in his family to graduate high school and college, Jessie is the son of immigrants whose resilience continues to inspire his deep commitment to justice and healing.

Jessie's career has spanned citywide HIV testing and condom distribution, school-based sexual health programs, LGBTQ+ peer networks, and nonprofit capacity-building. He previously served as a regional HIV testing trainer in Tennessee, certifying providers in culturally competent counseling, testing, and linkage-to-care services. At OUTMemphis, he led health and wellness initiatives addressing sexual and mental health, substance use, intimate partner violence, and created supportive spaces for LGBTQ+ Latinx and BIPOC communities.

Currently, Jessie is the Community Building Manager at the Latino Commission on AIDS, leading the Latinos in the South program. Based in Memphis, he coordinates regional education and capacity-building efforts across NC, SC, TN, AL, LA, GA, MS, TX, and FL, serving Latinx, immigrant, Black, Indigenous, LGBTQ+ communities and those impacted by HIV. He also supports the planning of Encuentro, the Commission's signature Southern gathering on health equity.

His work strengthens collaborations with local stakeholders, coalitions, and health departments to expand access to inclusive services and reduce stigma.

For Jessie, health equity means more than services—it means access, dignity, and power. "To me, healthy living in the South means having a wealth of resources—not just medical—readily available for all, regardless of income, education, legal status, or identity," he shares. "I don't just want to leave people with information—I want them to leave feeling confident, empowered, and seen."

Jessie's leadership has been recognized through numerous honors, including the Trailblazer Award from Focus Mid-South Magazine (2018), Standing Ovation Award from St. Jude Children's Research Hospital (2017), Light of Hope Award from the Shelby County Health Department (2017), and Leader of Tomorrow Award from Operation Stand Up (2017). He also proudly served as a founding team member of City Year Memphis in 2016.



Blvck Hippie is an Indie Rock Band from Memphis, TN tryna show Black kids they can be weird too.

Blvck Hippie makes VHS-inspired music for anyone who's ever felt like an outsider. By melding an emo sensibility with an indie rock aesthetic Blvck Hippie creates tunes for getting unstuck, existing weirdly, and finding togetherness. Raw vocals pair with sticky guitar riffs, heart-wrenching lyrics, and heavy breakdowns to create a live show for all of us raging inside. With their firmly indie attitude, refusal to

accept the status quo, and knack for pushing musical boundaries, Blvck Hippie has turned being an outsider into their superpower.

Blvck Hippie released their debut LP, If You Feel Alone At Parties in Fall 2021. Since then they've been touring across the US and Europe carving out a place for themselves on festival stages, at basement shows, and everywhere in between. Jasmine Albertson (KEXP) perfectly captures the must-experience nature of a Blvck Hippie show: "While their recorded material is fantastic, seeing the Memphisbased band live is an even more remarkable experience. The pure joy that emanates from every member of the primarily POC band is infectious and an absolute gift, especially considering the pain and hardships that inspired these songs." 
